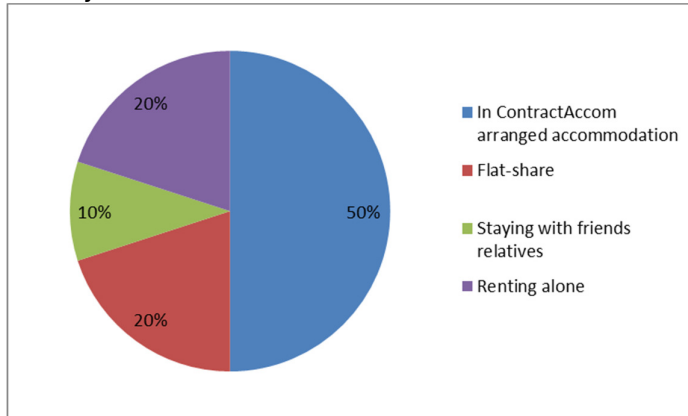


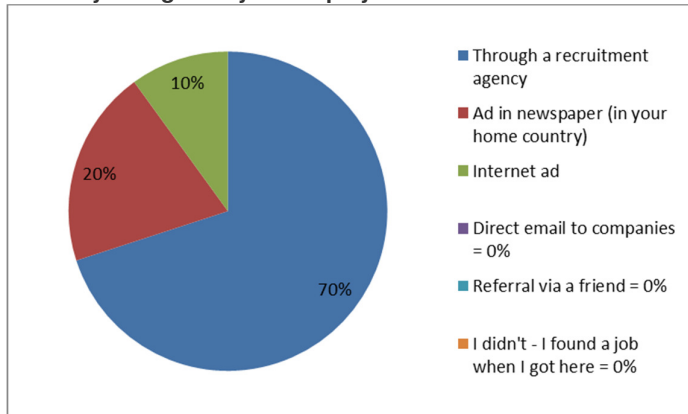
**Results of survey of contractors who have either been in ContractAccom accommodation or are still currently in ContractAccom accommodation.**

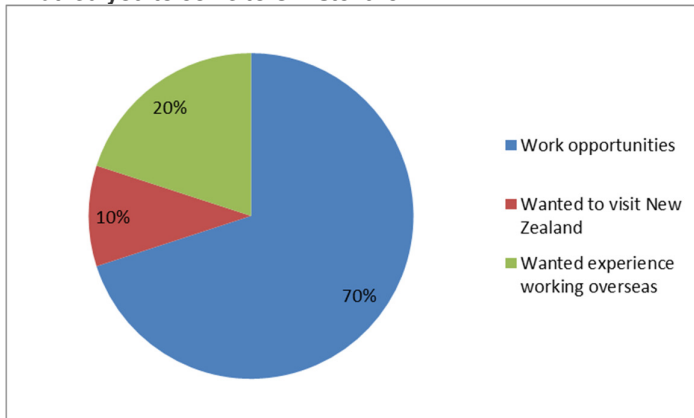
**1. What is your current accommodation situation in Christchurch?**



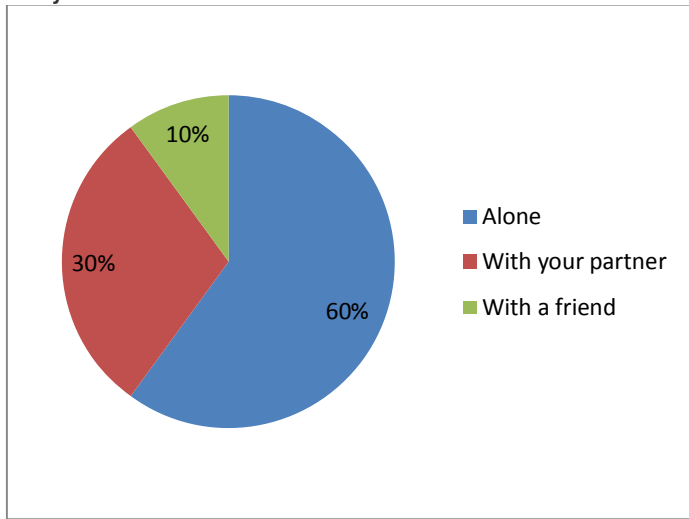
**2. How did you organise your employment in New Zealand before arriving?**



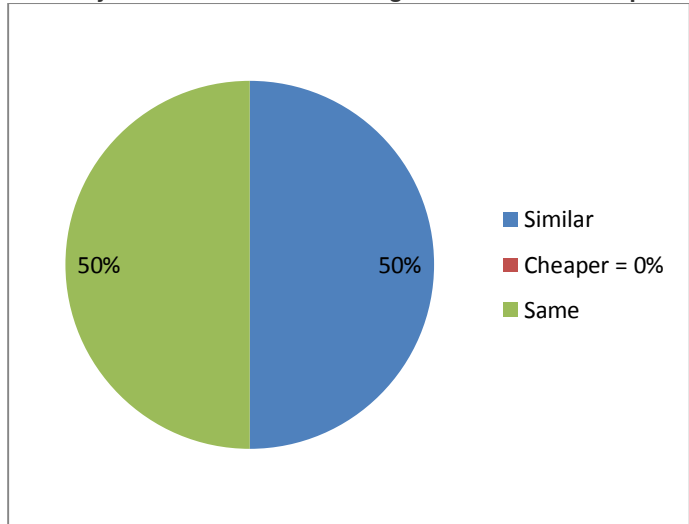
**3. What led you to come to Christchurch?**



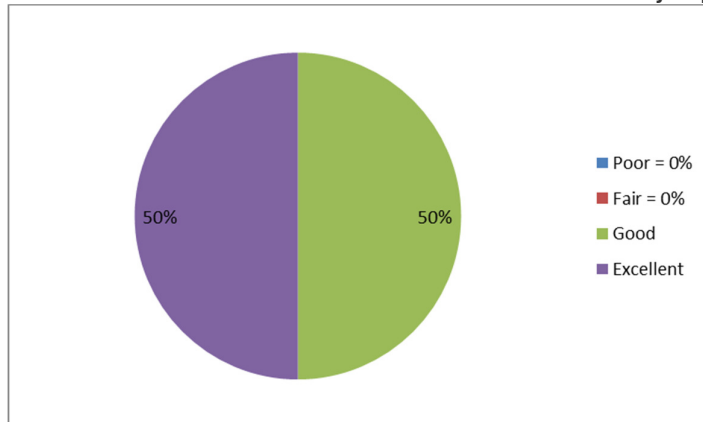
4. Did you come to Christchurch ...?



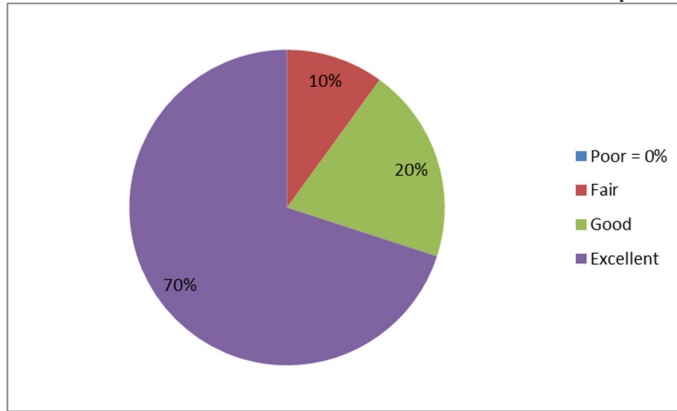
5. How do you believe the cost of living in Christchurch compares to where you have come from?



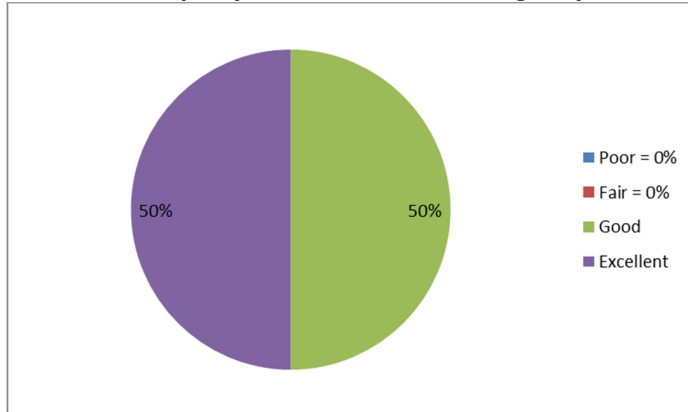
6. Please rate the usefulness information ContractAccom sent you prior to your arrival



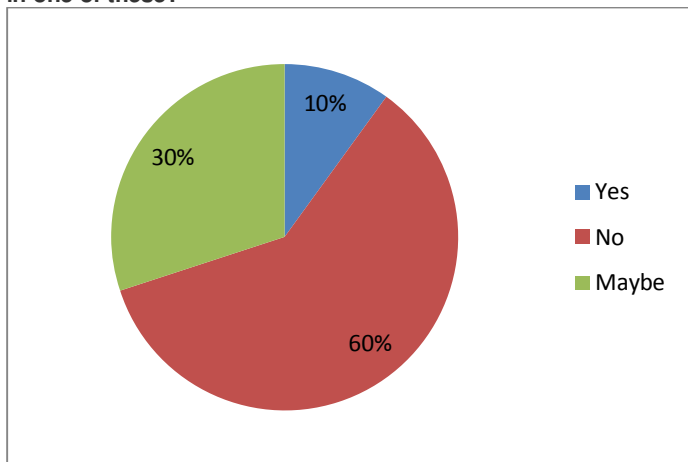
7. Please rate the usefulness of ContractAccom's welcome pack



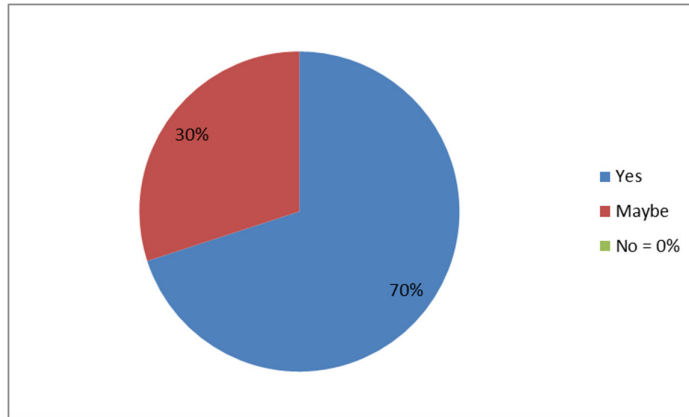
8. Please rate the quality of accommodation arranged by ContractAccom
